

POLICY No. 6-6

LARGE COMMERCIAL RATE: SCHEDULE C-2

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

To define and establish the large commercial rate class and rate.

POLICY CONTENT:

Applicability of Large Commercial Rate Schedule

The large commercial rate schedule applies to commercial, industrial, public authority or farming operations where the maximum demand is greater than 50 kW but not more than 2000 kW. However, this rate schedule does not apply to separately metered irrigation loads or loads designated as new large single loads.

Net Large Commercial Monthly Rates--After Application of Five Percent Prompt Payment Discount

Service Availability Charge: \$365.00 per month
Energy Charge: \$.057 per kWh
Demand Charge: \$7.82 per kW of demand exceeding 50 kW. Demand charges that vary from unity by more than 3 percent may be corrected to a 97 percent power factor, leading or lagging, for billing purposes.

Special Conditions: If service is provided at primary voltage, a 5 percent discount will be applied to demand charges.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

The CEO is responsible for developing procedures to bill qualifying members under this rate schedule.
