

POLICY No. 6-9

LARGE IRRIGATION RATE: SCHEDULE I-2

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

To define and establish the large irrigation rate class and rate.

POLICY CONTENT:

Applicability of Large Irrigation Rate Schedule

The large irrigation rate schedule shall apply to separately metered agricultural irrigation accounts of 75 horsepower or more.

Net Large Irrigation Monthly Rates--After Application of Five Percent Prompt Payment Discount

Service Availability Charge: \$6.88 per horsepower billed annually at the beginning of the irrigation season to all active and idle services.

Demand Charge: \$6.78 per kW of demand. Demand charges may be waived for the time from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday and all-day Saturday and Sunday, for members who need minimal energy in scenarios such as moving circles, testing pumps or filling livestock troughs or ponds. Arrangements for the waiver must be made in advance with the member service manager.

Energy Charge: May through September \$0.038 per kWh
October through April \$0.047 per kWh

Prepayment: Members with a history of delinquent balances may be required to prepay an irrigation bill or provide other security in lieu of prepayment.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

The CEO is responsible for developing procedures to bill qualifying members under this rate schedule.
