

POLICY No. 6-4A

SUPPLEMENTAL RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE: SCHEDULE B

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

To define supplemental residential service rate class and establish electric rates for that class.

POLICY CONTENT:

Applicability of Supplemental Residential Service Rate Schedule

1. Electric service is required by a member served under a residential rate for purposes supplemental to the service received under Schedule A and no more than 500 kWh's per month on average are used.
2. Examples to apply this rate include, but are not limited to, workshops, sheds, barns, member-owned lighting, pumps and docks.
3. Locations under this rate cannot be used for residential living or commercial purposes, must be located on the same legal parcel as the residential account, share a common transformer and are supplemental to and must remain the responsibility of the same member.

Net Supplemental Residential Service Monthly Rates--After Application of Five Percent Prompt Payment Discount:

Service Availability Charge – Single Phase:	\$12.29 per month (one half of the residential rate in Policy 6-4)
kWh Charge:	\$0.0680 per kWh

RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

The CEO is responsible for developing procedures to bill qualifying customers under this rate schedule.
